

# Pastor's Perspective

Following the Shepherd

For the past two months since Easter, we have been working through Psalm 23 during our Sunday morning worship service. Charles Spurgeon referred to Psalm 23 as the "Pearl of the Psalms" and after this series I hope you can see why. I know many of you have been blessed and encouraged by this series, and I have been blessed to hear from you how the Lord has used this Psalm in your lives.

As a summary reflection on this series as we head into summer, I wanted to share a brief devotional by Tim Keller on Psalm 23. This is from his year-long devotional on the Psalms entitled "The Songs of Jesus," where each day has a simple, but powerful reflection and prayer on the psalms. Here is what Keller writes for Psalm 23:

"God has a celebration meal with us not after we finally get out of the dark valley but in the middle of it, in the presence of our enemies. He wants us to rejoice in him in the midst of our troubles. Is our shepherd out of touch with reality? Hardly. Jesus is the only shepherd who knows what it is like to be a sheep (John 10:11). He understands what we are going through and will be with us every step of the way, even through death itself, where 'all other guides turn back' (Romans 8:39)."

And then Keller offers this prayer:

"Lord, if I fed on your love, grace, and truth, I would not be in any want. In this life I will never attain that, yet you are always with me, and someday you will lead me to my true country, the home I've been longing for all my life. Help me rest in that. Amen."

As we head into this summer, with new opportunities to reconnect with one another, to serve one another, and to reach out into our community with the good news of Jesus, may this prayer be on our hearts...may we constantly feed on the Lord's love, grace, and truth. And if we stay close to our shepherd and continue to receive his provision and guidance, then we will have plenty of love, grace, and truth to share with one another and with a world who desperately needs it.
