Pastor's Perspective

A Simple Path to Radical Devotion

"They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. All the believers were together and had everything in common. They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved."

I love this description of the early church in the book of Acts. It describes a group of believers who love Jesus, love each other, worship together, grow together, and serve together. Isn't that a beautiful picture of the body of Christ in motion?

This past year has been a wonderful year of growing together as we have worked through a very difficult season. My favorite moments from 2021 have been our times together as a church family, whether that was a Sunday morning, summer BBQs, church workdays, home fellowships, or one of the other ways we came together as a church this past year. And I don't think I'm alone in praying for our church family of Mission Village Christian Fellowship to continue to grow together in 2022!

So how can we continue to grow together this year? One of the keys to growth in this passage is the first phrase: "They devoted themselves...". The

way it is worded in the original Greek language, the phrase means "they were continually devoting themselves." Devotion was not a one-time commitment; it was an everyday commitment, and even an hour by hour minute by minute commitment.

This kind of ongoing continual devotion is hard for us to fathom, especially in a digital age. We're bombarded by activities, news, social media feeds, and demands of family and work. And when we are doing one thing, we're distracted in our minds by ten other things. It is hard to be fully devoted to one thing for more than an hour, let alone continually devoted to that one thing.

So how can we cultivate the kind of ongoing continual spiritual devotion we see in Acts 2? We could look at this passage and make a long checklist of spiritual disciplines and to-do lists for 2022, sort of like a New Year's Resolution list. But if you've been around this church for a few years, you know I'm not a fan of New Year's Resolutions...we make a long list of things to do, and we fail at most of them within a few weeks and then feel worse about ourselves because of it.

So let's simplify this beautiful passage in Acts into two easy steps that will certainly grow our spiritual devotion in 2022: 1. Show up. 2. Help. That's it. We see the early church always together and always caring for one another. Show up. Help. These are simple steps, but they lead to radical devotion.

Collin Hansen is the editor-in-chief for the Gospel Coalition and an elder in his church. In his recent book *Rediscover Church* he writes this: "When I talk with new church members, I make a big promise. And so far, no one has ever returned to complain that I misled them. I promise that if they show up consistently and seek to care for others, they will get everything they want out of the church."

So if you want to grow in your spiritual devotion this year, show up and help. Come and serve. If you already attend every Sunday but are not yet part of a mid-week home fellowship or bible study, join one this year. If you need help finding a ministry to serve in, come talk to me. If you already serve in a ministry here at the church, speak to me about how you can dive deeper into that ministry or take on another ministry opportunity. Show up. Help. The more you take these simple steps, the more your spiritual devotion will grow!

I am looking forward to a wonderful year of growing together and following Jesus together, and I hope you are too!
