Pastor's perspective

"His pleasure is not in the strength of the horse, nor his delight in the legs of the warrior; the Lord delights in those who fear him, who put their hope in his unfailing love."

As we go into a new year, I would imagine that many, if not most of you are making some kind of New Year's Resolution. I tend to not be a huge fan of New Year's Resolutions, because we try so hard in our own strength to make improvements to our lives, and then when we fail we just feel bad about ourselves. Yet despite the low success rate we still make those resolutions, hoping that we can somehow be a better person in the new year.

One thing that may help us with our resolutions going into a new year is to ask ourselves this: what motivation lies behind my resolution? In other words, what is leading me to make this resolution in the first place? If we are honest with ourselves, many of the resolutions we make going into a new year are driven by a desire to want to feel better about ourselves. We want to exercise more so that we are in better shape so that we feel better about ourselves. We want to make more money so that we have more financial stability so that we feel better about ourselves. Even our spiritual resolutions, such as wanting to read the bible more or spend more time in prayer, while excellent goals, can often be fueled by a sense of not measuring up, not being good enough, and needing to do more for God so that we can please God and in turn we can then...you guessed it...feel better about ourselves.

Pastor's perspective continued

What an encouragement then to find that God's delight in us does not depend on our efforts to please him! The psalmist writes, "His pleasure is not in the strength of the horse, nor his delight in the legs of the warrior; the Lord delights in those who fear him, who put their hope in his unfailing love." What a relief to know that God's delight in me is not dependent on my feeble efforts to please him! Even when we struggle in our faith we still don't need to question God's delight in us. Tim Keller highlights this when he writes of this psalm, "(God's) delight does not wax and wane depending on my performance but is unvarying because I am in Christ."

So if you are a follower of Jesus, God delights in you. God does not delight in you because of what you will do for him this year, nor does God delight in you for how you will grow closer to him this year. God delights in you because you are in Christ.

This should encourage and help us in at least two ways as we head into a new year. First, because God already delights in us as followers of Jesus, any effort we make to honor, serve, and grow closer to God this year is not done to earn God's favor, but done because we have already received God's favor. That makes all the difference in the world when it comes to our motivation to grow in our spiritual disciplines and practices this year. While it is draining to try and grow spiritually because you are trying to please God, it is life-giving to try and grow spiritually when you know God already delights in you.

Second, because God already delights in us as followers of Jesus, any resolutions we do make in this new year can be made without the burden of trying to feel better about ourselves. If you find that you are struggling to feel better about yourself, maybe a good practice going into a new year is not to make a long list of resolutions you think will help, but rather to start the year by praying this: "Lord, help me to see myself the way you see me. Help me to value myself the way you value me. Help me not to make my assessment of myself based on my successes and failures this year, but to simply to see myself as your (already) beloved child. Help me to walk with you, serve you, and grow closer to you this year without the burden of self-worth attached to my efforts. Thank you that you delight in me already, because I belong to Jesus. In Jesus' name, Amen."

If you find that this prayer resonates with you or challenges you, make sure to tell a brother or sister in Christ who can pray for you and encourage you in this new year. And then, as God's beloved children, let us see what he would have for us in this new year.
